Heather started playing guitar and singing in early childhood. She grew up in a farming community isolated from most musical learning opportunities. Instead she would listen to her mum's records and learn to sing and play them "by ear". Heather started writing her own songs early and with an obvious natural talent for music, she was encouraged to record her first demo tape of original songs in 1994 at age 14. Heather soon became engaged in professional music concerts and theatre productions in Adelaide, while at secondary school.
